

# **51**<sup>st</sup> **Annual USS Thresher Memorial Service**, Reported by TB Commander Kevin Galeaz

- 1. R.W. Traip Auditorium & Foyer will be rented from 1000-1600 on Saturday, April 12<sup>th</sup>. R.W Traip Auditorium doors will be open to attendees at 1130.
- 2. Rental forms for the <u>R.W. Traip Academy</u> have been submitted and approved by the <u>Kittery Schools Department</u>. R.W. Traip Academy and Kittery Schools Department required formal event insurance policy. Policy was selected and purchased.
